



## 2018 6 Nations Ticket Application Process

Dear All

With the change in the RFU's ticketing system, I would like to invite members of LSRFUR to apply for an initial maximum of a pair per match by email to [ticketsecretary@londonrugby.com](mailto:ticketsecretary@londonrugby.com) on or after 00.01 on 20th November, but before 23.59 on 10th December.

- 10th February England v Wales KO 16.45
- 17th March England v Ireland KO 14.45

The tickets are priced £105, £96, £65 & £41 and the Society's tickets are in minimum blocks of 10. I will do my best to allocate tickets of a higher face value than you are prepared to pay, provided you give me this information.

If you want to increase your chances of getting a ticket to see a match, only apply for a single because such applications will be prioritised. (and the ticket will be adjacent to other LSRFUR members). It is helpful if applicants also state their role in the Society; i.e. Retired, Committee Member, Assessor, Adviser, Coach, Active Ref, Occasional Ref, etc.

I will then advise members of their allocation, request a postal address and provide payment arrangements towards end of December.

Tickets (which must be for your own use), will then be despatched 2 – 3 weeks before the first home match.

Over 30% of recent applications did not comply with my simple requests, so in an attempt to minimise the possibility of applications being rejected on technical grounds, here is a little checklist:

1. Is the application within the time period?
2. Have you stated the £max you are prepared to pay per ticket?
3. Have you stated your role in the LSRFUR?
